Did You Know?

Did you know that Berners Barnwell Sams (1787-1855) had fifteen children?

B.B. Sams' first eleven children were by his first wife, Elizabeth Hann Fripp (1795-1831) and the next four children were by his second wife, Martha Edwards (1799-1857). No wonder he built additions on both sides of the plantation house! He and both of his wives are buried in the Sams family cemetery near the plantation ruins on Dataw. William Washington Sams and Ariana Adeline Sams are also buried in the Elizabeth Hann Fripp Sams | Berners Barwell Sams family cemetery.
